Qualifying applicants must be a full-time student at the University of Maine, Husson University or Eastern Maine Community College, and maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average. Candidates should be physically fit, non-smoker, and have at least 2 years of school or four semesters remaining.

Prior firefighting or EMS experience is helpful but not required. We provide all necessary training and equipment.
